SCOPE

4th ISEAC Triennial International Conference on ElectroAnalytical Chemistry and Allied Topics (ELAC-2010) is being organised under the aegis of Indian Society for ElectroAnalytical Chemistry (ISEAC) at Toshali Sands, Puri, Orissa, India during March 16-18, 2010. The ELAC-2010 is aimed at updating the scientists with the latest developments in the field and exposing the participants to new developments in the electroanalytical techniques and innumerable applications of electrochemistry in different areas. The Scientific Programme of ELAC-2010 would consist of lectures by Specialists from Universities, Industries and R&D Establishments from within India and Overseas as well as contributed papers.

RESEARCH SCHOLARS' PRESENTATIONS

It is planned to have oral presentations during the Conference from Research Scholars who are working in the area of electrochemistry and have submitted their M.Sc. / Ph.D. thesis after 3rd ISEAC Triennial International Conference ELAC-2007. Research scholars are requested to send their one recent passport size coloured photograph along with the Nomination Form duly signed by the Research Guide. A panel of judges will evaluate the Research Scholars' oral presentations for awards. The person who wins the **Best Research Scholar Award** would be provided with financial support for attending the next Scientific Meeting organised by ISEAC, provided he / she presents a paper. This includes waiver of registration fee as well as free boarding and lodging. In addition, a cash prize of Rs. 1000/- and a merit certificate will also be given.

CONTRIBUTED PAPERS

All Contributed Papers will be presented as Posters (~1m x 1m). The authors will have to be present for discussions during the time specified for poster sessions. The posters will be evaluated by a panel of judges for cash awards and merit certificates.

VENDORS' ORAL SESSION

A special oral session (strictly technical) will be organized for the Vendors / Instrument manufacturers to

highlight the latest developments in the electroanalytical Instrumentation and Applications.

EXHIBITION

An exhibition will be held in conjunction with the ELAC-2010 at the same venue for electrochemical equipments, material characterization instruments and other products like chemicals suppliers, apparatus etc. Please contact Chairman, Organising Committee at Mumbai for information about exhibition stalls and charges.

AUTHORS PLEASE NOTE

The manuscripts of the Invited Talks, Contributed papers, Research Scholars presentations and instrument Manufacturers' presentations will be published in the form of a bound Volume which will be released during Inaugural Function.

1. All the manuscripts formatted strictly as per the guidelines given in the link provided on ISEAC website: www.iseac.org should be sent through e-mail to Convener, Organising Committee on or before **February 8, 2010**. In case, the above link is not available, authors can write to the Convener for sending the guidelines by e-mail.
2. All symbols used in the manuscript should be used by "insert" option and not by changing the Font Style.
3. Manuscripts of the Invited Talks should not exceed 15 pages.
4. Authors of Invited Talks / Short Lectures should send ten to fifteen lines of bio-data in a CD / by e-mail.
5. Manuscripts of Research Scholars Presentations, Contributed Papers and Vendors Session should not exceed 4 pages.
6. In the case of manuscripts of Research Scholars Presentations, the name of the Research Scholar should be underlined and an asterisk should be put on the Guide's name.
7. Research Scholars should send the Nomination Form duly signed by the Research Guide along with the manuscript.
8. Invited Speakers and Research Scholars should send one passport size coloured photograph.

ISEAC JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS AWARDS (Nine)

Nine ISEAC Awards (Three for each year of 2007, 2008 and 2009) will be given to the authors of the Papers in any area of Electrochemistry, published in Peer Reviewed Journals by Indian Scientists based on the work done in India. The pdf files or hard copies of papers published during 2007, 2008 and 2009 in journals should be communicated to President, ISEAC. One of the authors should be ISEAC life-member to qualify for award. The papers will be evaluated by a committee appointed by ISEAC and awards will be conferred during the ELAC-2010 Inauguration Function on March 16, 2010. The award will consist of Cash prize of Rs. 2K and a Merit Certificate. It is also proposed to include a list of papers published in 2007, 2008 and 2009 in the bound Volume of ELAC-2010 as well as display all the journal papers on all the days of the Conference for the benefit of ELAC-2010 delegates.

ISEAC EMINENT SCIENTIST AWARDS

Three ISEAC Awards will be conferred on individuals for their excellent contributions in any branch of Electrochemistry in India. *Self-nominations are allowed.* The nomination should include complete biodata, photograph, list of important journal publications in the area of electrochemistry (last 5 years), visits abroad (last 5years), number of Ph.D./M.Sc. students guided, national and international collaborations (if any), awards received, names, addresses and email IDs of two referees from within India or overseas, one paragraph for citation and 2 page summary of the work performed. The nominations will be scrutinized by a committee appointed by ISEAC and awardees will be announced prior to the Conference. The awardees will be required to present 30 minutes award lecture on March 16, 2010. The award will consist of Cash prize of Rs. 10K and a citation.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE
