

Awards Instituted by ISEAC

The following awards are instituted by ISEAC and will be conferred every three years starting from ELAC-2010 Conference at Puri.

1. ISEAC JOURNAL PUBLICATIONS AWARDS (Nine)

Nine ISEAC Awards (Three for each year of 2007, 2008 and 2009) to the Papers in any area of Electrochemistry, published in Peer Reviewed Journals by Indian Scientists based on the work done in India. The pdf files or hard copies of papers published during 2007, 2008 and 2009 in Journals should be communicated to the address given below. One of the authors should be ISEAC life-member. The papers will be evaluated by a Committee appointed by ISEAC and awards will be conferred during the ELAC-2010 Inauguration Function on March 16, 2010. **The award will consist of Cash prize of Rs. 2K and a Certificate. It is also proposed to display all the papers during the Conference for benefit of ELAC-2010 delegates. A complete list of all the papers will also be published in ELAC-2010 bound Volume.**

2. ISEAC EMINENT SCIENTIST AWARDS (Three)

Three ISEAC Awards to individuals for their excellent contributions in any branch of Electrochemistry in India. Self-nominations are allowed. The nomination should include complete biodata, photograph, list of important journal publications in the area of electrochemistry (last 5 years), visits abroad (last 5 years), number of Ph.D./M.Sc. students guided,

national and international collaborations (if any), awards received previously; names, addresses and email IDs of two referees from within India or overseas, one paragraph for citation and 2 page summary of the work performed. The nominations will be scrutinized by a Committee appointed by ISEAC and awardees will be announced prior to Conference. **The awardees will be required to present 30 minutes award lecture on March 16, 2010. The award will consist of a Cash prize of RS. 10K and a citation.**

3. ISEAC CONTRIBUTED PAPERS AWARDS (Minimum Five) and RESEARCH SCHOLAR BEST THESIS PRESENTATION AWARD

As in the previous ELAC Conference and DM Meetings, the contributed papers presented as posters will be judged by experts for the Poster presentation style, technical content and questions/answers during poster sessions. Minimum five awards will be given. The awards consist of cash prize of RS. 1K and merit certificates.

Best thesis presentation award would also be given for oral presentation to one of the students who have completed their Ph.Ds or M.Sc. after ELAC-2007 Conference. The award comprises cash of Rs. 1K and a merit certificate. In addition, the winner will also be entitled to completely free participation, including travel by AC II tier (train), in the next ISEAC event, provided he/she submits a contribution in the Conference/Discussion Meet. **All the selected award winners are expected to join ISEAC as life-members within three months.**

NOTE: *The decision of ISEAC appointed Committees will be final. No correspondence will be entertained for the awards/awardees selected by ISEAC.
